- (1) Register online for the NYE event at the UCC website.
- (2) Register online for PSEC bus transportation, scholarship assistance, and/or to receive your PSEC t-shirt on the PSEC website. Important dates:



- **Jan 20** - Registration opened for the NYE event AND for the PSEC bus scholarship assistance, and t-shirt.
- **Apr 4** - Deadline to register for scholarship assistance for youth. The pool of money will be divided by the number of applicants who will be notified of the amount of the scholarship he/she will receive by **Apr 11**.
- **May 27** - Deadline to register for both the NYE event and PSEC bus.
- **Jun 4** - If you pay by check for PSEC bus transportation, the check must be received by Jun 4. Mail the check made out to **PSEC** to PSEC, 1441 Laura Lane, Suite 100, Pottstown, PA 19464.

When the first white settlers crossed the Blue Mountains and settled in what is now known as South Manheim Township, Schuylkill County, they brought with them their faith and loyalty to God. In the midst of their trying experiences of settling in a wilderness that was inhabited by Indians, they

"looked to the hills from whence came their help" and on the top of the Summer Hill they founded and built their house of worship. This church dates back to the days preceding the Revolutionary War, and the Declaration of Independence.

From its origin until 1959, St. Paul's was a union church, alternating services with it's neighboring Lutheran congregation. In December 1958, fire destroyed the old Union Church, whereupon, each congregation built its own place of worship. Through the years this congregation has maintained a rich tradition of worship and service to both the local and world community. We strive through the guidance of the Holy Spirit to remain faithful to the mission and message of Jesus Christ. As a Christian community of faith, we at St. Paul's are called to share the love God has extended to us so graciously in Jesus Christ.
