Thirty-One delegates, family and visitors from PSEC traveled to Baltimore, Maryland for the 31st national gathering of the United Church of Christ. Things you need to know include:



Three Great Loves Officially Announced and Kicked Off

"What is Three Great Loves? It is a call to the love of children, to the love of neighbor, and to the love of creation," Dorhauer told the gathering on Saturday morning, July 1. "During the next biennium, we want to discover what an entire denomination committed to Three Great Loves can do to change the world."

The Shaping our Future Campaign-- A capital campaign to support the ministry of the Office of General Minister and President specifically for:
 1. Tech support (via Mission inside and Zoom) 2. To develop a market strategy campaign (Three Great Loves) and 3. Shift our church culture toward entrepreneurial and Innovative leadership. It's a three-year campaign that will kick off in September with \$2 million in pledges already committed.

Delegates debated 21 resolutions including Environmental Imperatives for a New Moral Era "The climate crisis is an opportunity for which the church was born," said Rev. Jim Antal, president and conference minister for the Massachusetts Conference United Church of Christ, and the author of the resolution. "This sets the stage for engagement and hope. This is a proclamation of truth and the love of God's gift."
