Plant a Yard Sign for the Paris Accord

In response to the United States pulling out of the Paris Climate Accord, General Synod passed an emergency resolution entitled <u>"The</u> Earth Is the Lord's—Not Ours to Wreck."

With 16 conferences as sponsors and 97% of delegates voting in its favor, the resolution reflects a denomination in which two recent surveys found that climate is the number one issue of concern for members.



As a tangible act of witness related to the resolution, churches are Invited to plant yard signs that declare,

"We [heart] Planet Earth. We Support the Paris Accord."

Ventures 2017


Registration deadline is September 8.
