

Setting PSEC News as a Default Startup Page

The Pennsylvania Southeast Conference website's News & Updates page is filled with regularly updated information that is valuable to Authorized Ministers, church secretaries, and other church leaders. It should be checked regularly. PSEC is encouraging all clergy and lay leaders to set the webpage as a startup page on your internet browser, so that every time you open your browser to use the internet, the first page that appears will be these valuable updates.

Google Chrome:

1. On your computer, open Chrome.
2. At the top right, below the X button, click the more button (it looks like three dots in a vertical line) and then click Settings.
3. Under "On startup," select "Open a specific page or set of pages" or "Manage on startup pages."
4. Click "Add a new page" and enter the web address: <http://www.psec.org/news>

Internet Explorer:

1. Open your Control Panel.
2. Double-click "Internet" or "Internet Options."
3. In the address box under "Home page", type in <http://www.psec.org/news>
4. Click OK.

Safari:

1. Choose Safari > Preferences, then click General.
2. In the Homepage field, enter <http://www.psec.org/news>
3. Choose when your homepage is shown:
 - a. *Open new windows with your homepage:* Click the "New windows open with" pop-up menu, then choose Homepage.
 - b. *Open new tabs with your homepage:* Click the "New tabs open with" pop-up menu, then choose Homepage.

Mozilla Firefox:

1. On your computer, open Firefox.
2. At the top right, below the X button, click on the more button (it looks like three vertical lines) and then click Options.
3. Under the General tab, make sure that the box next to "When Firefox starts" is set to "Show my home page."
4. Next to Home Page, enter <http://www.psec.org/news>
