Camp Noah Kids Kits

Every child at Camp Noah receives a Kids Kit to use and then take home at the end of camp. Children are thrilled to receive the Kits, especially since they often replace items damaged or lost in the disaster.

Each Kids Kit contains these items:

- (1) Pack broad line washable markers (classic colors)
- (1) 8-count washable watercolor paints with brush
- (1) Glue stick
- (1) 24 count box of crayons
- (1) Kids-sized scissors
- (1) Black Pen
- (1) Pencil (unsharpened)
- (1) Pencil sharpener
- (1) 5-ounce container of Play-Doh (any color)

Package these items into a gallon-sized plastic freezer bag and it's a Kids Kit!

Note: *Fairness is very important to children, so we ask that you provide only Crayola brand markers, crayons, and watercolor paints so every Kids Kit is the same.*
