The updated curriculum is introduced in four phases. Each phase is six to eight weeks and is intended to lead participants into



conversations leading to sustainable actions that are historical and foundational to the *how* race was constructed, *who* constructed and sanctioned race as model for American society, and *what* role the Christian Church played in supporting the division of humanity by skin color categories as a means for instituting the global European colonialism project.
