"3 Great Loves is you, me, all of us, collectively, as a united church, putting 'hands and feet' to our purpose, vision and mission statements," said Sigmund. "Living out our love for God, living and giving God's love. Seeking to make a just world for all through the lens of 3 Great Loves — Love of Neighbor, Love of Children, and Love of Creation. 3 Great Loves is sharing the stories of how all of us are living out that love, God's love, in missional, measurable, and meaningful ways."
