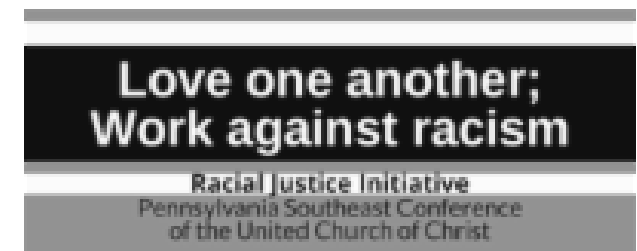
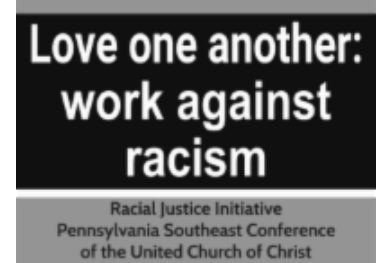
**Racial Justice Banners and Yard Signs Available**
