

## BIO for The Rev. Dr. John Dorhauer:

Rev. Dr. John Dorhauer is passionate about justice. With a personal theology shaped in the passionate conviction that God is love and God is just, John Dorhauer has embodied the United Church of Christ's vision of "A Just World for All" throughout his ministry. During his doctoral studies at United Theological Seminary (2004), his area of focus was white privilege and its effects on the church. He initiated the collaborative creation of a curriculum, "White Privilege: Let's Talk – A Resource for Transformational Dialogue", designed to invite UCC members and others to engage in safe, meaningful, substantive, and bold conversations on race. Rev. Dorhauer now serves as Vice-Chair of the National Council of Churches (NCC), and has co-chaired the NCC's United to End Racism campaign.
