

**Pennsylvania Southeast Conference**  
**Minutes for Spring Meeting, June 8, 2024**  
**@ The Penn Stater & via Zoom**

The Pennsylvania Southeast Conference Spring Meeting was held on June 8, 2024, at The Penn Stater in State College, Pennsylvania. Following a brief worship service led by the Worship Team, Rev. Bill Worley, Conference Minister, welcomed everyone to the meeting. He welcomed first time attendees to the meeting and asked the PSEC staff, Dean of Church & Ministry Council, members of the Church & Ministry Council, Association Moderators, Consistory members, MIDs, members of the Worship Team, members of the Tech Team, and members of the Planning Team to stand and receive appreciation for their leadership. Rev. Worley introduced Mr. Charles Kuthuru, Conference Moderator.

The business session was called to order at 9:27 am by Moderator, Mr. Kuthuru.

Motion to appoint Vice-Moderator, Rev. Melissa Burkhart as Credentials Chair by Rev. David Heckler, Christ Church, Trumbauersville and seconded by Rev. Ann Few, Falkner Swamp Reformed, Gilbertsville. There was no discussion. The motion carried.

1. Credentials Report – 150 voting delegates are needed to reach quorum, present at the meeting were 135 voting delegates (89 clergy, 41 church delegates, and 5 consistory and lay members), a quorum was not reached.

Per our Constitution and By-Laws, Article V, 5a. states:

In the absence of a quorum, the Conference Consistory shall be empowered to act upon the proposed business of the regular or special Conference meeting.

With this in mind the additional business items were set aside for the Consistory to act upon at their July meeting.

The remainder of the meeting focused on the 2025 budget and the Keystone Study Group.

The meeting adjourned at 11:50 am. Rev. Bill Worley closed the meeting with prayer.
