From the Addiction & Recovery Taskforce: Recovery Texts

The Task Force has Alcoholics Anonymous (AA), Narcotics Anonymous (NA), and Recovery Dharma textbooks to offer for people who want to better understand addiction, see what recovery is about, perhaps begin their own journey, or give to someone who may be in need. NA Basic Text: A book that is intended as a complete textbook for every addict seeking recovery, describing the NA program and how it works. It includes the spiritual principles, the NA Twelve Steps and Twelve Traditions, as well as many personal stories of people who have found freedom from addiction through Narcotics Anonymous.

AA Big Book: A book that details the cornerstone concepts of recovery from alcohol addiction, explains the A.A. program, the 12 Steps and 12 Traditions, the history of A.A., and tells the stories of men and women who have overcome the disease by sharing their personal experiences.

<u>Recovery Dharma</u>: This book describes a way to be free from the suffering of addiction using Buddhist practices and principles. The program is based on the idea that everyone is their own guide in recovery from addiction, with the help and understanding of wise friends and sangha (community).
