## PSEC Emails Being Spammed

As many of you are aware, we are constantly fighting the battle of our PSEC emails being spammed. This is when someone takes one of our names and under a totally different email address sends out a message in our name asking for something like gift cards. Because our email addresses are public, it is easy for this to happen, and unfortunately there is no way for our tech team to prevent it.

Please remember the following points that we have shared in the past and will continue to share into the future.

1. **No one from the Conference will ever ask you to go out and purchase gift cards for ANY reason.**
2. Another email goes out saying "I need a favor, please email me but do not call, I'm in a meeting". (No offense but if one of us needs assistance we would contact our families or a fellow employee.)
3. Always check the return address! This is crucial. Look closely if it does not have one of our names followed by [@psec.org](mailto:@psec.org) it is not from us.
  - a. A good way to check this if the address is hidden is to hit reply and see what address a reply would be going to. DO NOT send any reply.
  - b. Our emails are: [worley@psec.org](mailto:worley@psec.org), [mclmore@psec.org](mailto:mclmore@psec.org), [james@psec.org](mailto:james@psec.org), [bookkeeper@psec.org](mailto:bookkeeper@psec.org), [brea@psec.org](mailto:brea@psec.org), [susan@psec.org](mailto:susan@psec.org), [tammie@psec.org](mailto:tammie@psec.org),
4. Often times, the wording in the email is not correct. It is obvious someone who does not have English as their first language has sent it.
5. Unless you are 100% certain you know the email is coming from the correct email address NEVER, NEVER, NEVER, did I remember to say NEVER OPEN any attachment. (One of our churches did this and it was a major job, and an expensive one, to fix the situation.)
6. Lastly, if you are still unsure, call our office BEFORE doing anything.
7. Follow your gut, if you think something isn't right – it isn't!
8. Finally, and most importantly, be vigilant!
