A Message From Our Conference Minister

Dear Friends,

This New Year will be one of change and transition for our Conference. We will transform the sixty-three-year ministry of the Pennsylvania Southeast Conference into part of the new Keystone Conference of the United Church of Christ. There will be sad endings and exciting, new beginnings. There will be hard work, a good deal of stress, some anxiety, and unintended confusion. There will be prayers for grace and patience and friends committed to enlarging the table around which Jesus calls us.

The Keystone Working Group that lead us to the November 9 decisions that formed one Conference continues their work this Friday keeping us faithful to our process and timeline. That Group, along with Committees comprised of members from each Conference, are working on the following:

- 1. Establishing an infrastructure for search and call. Penn Northeast and Penn West have long utilized volunteer infrastructures to facilitate this work. We're looking to engage that model across the state.
- 2. **Gathering Association presidents/moderators** to begin cross-Conference discussions regarding constitutional and ecclesial responsibilities of UCC Associations that are mission critical for the health and wellness of congregations and clergy. If you are an Association President, you should have received a doodle poll to establish future meeting dates.
- 3. **Finalize decisions related to logistics** such as future office space location, territories for Regional Conference Ministers, data storage and website, and the like.
- 4. **Financial conversations and decisions** as we combine four operating budgets, endowment and investment funds, and the accounting policies and procedures that maintain a high bar of transparency and fiducial responsibility.

- 5. Complete the final draft version of the Keystone Constitution and Bylaws so that you may review those (at your leisure or in as-yet-to-be-scheduled Town Hall Meetings) in preparation for their adoption at the spring meetings of each Conference.
- 6. Prepare General Synod Delegates to represent our four Conferences and the future of the Keystone Conference at the 35th General Synod in Kansas City, MO this July where the motion for merger, passed at the Fall Conference Meeting, comes to the Synod floor.

Additionally, there are Committees that have begun conversations about Generosity and Stewardship, Ecumenical Ministry, Missions, and Conference staff.

Finally, the PSEC Annual Meeting Planning Team and Conference Consistory are preparing for the last two meetings of our Conference. The first, **The Annual Spring Meeting, is Saturday, May 31 at Zwingli UCC in Souderton, PA** when we will adopt the Keystone Constitution and Bylaws and elect a Transitional Keystone Board of Directors (both of which can only take effect pending the approval of the General Synod motion to merge).


